EMERGENCIES AND SUPPORT FOR PEOPLE

Following the earthquake that devastated parts of Turkey and Syria, **Emmaus International** launched a **solidarity appeal** with the key aim of funding medium-term support for people in the disaster areas.



6 joint events, 3 partners supported.

CAMPAIGNING AND ADVOCACY WORK

Emmaus groups carry out campaigning work at the local level and also put together a **joint political statement**. Emmaus International also offers support to other organisations and social movements that share in our struggle.



5,000 beneficiaries of Emmaus mutual health organisations.

ACCESS TO RIGHTS PROGRAMMES

Emmaus International is developing **mutual health programmes** for group members in Africa and Asia. Relying on our member organisations' action on the ground, we are also calling for water infrastructures to be managed by the community, which is a fundamental right.



An average of €13,694 in aid per group, 30 groups supported.

ANNUAL SOLIDARITY PROGRAMME

Projects supported within the framework of this programme tend to be centred around investments: **building, renovation, repairs, purchasing materials, etc.**, for the daily upkeep of the group's economic and social activity.



Countries involved in this programme: Libya, Ukraine, Peru, Chile.

EMERGENCY FUND

The goal of this fund is **to support groups that run into severe difficulty**, thus threatening their members and their work, such as a health crisis, armed conflict, natural disasters, etc.



8 projects funded in Europe, Asia, Latin America and Africa.

HOUSING PROGRAMME

Supported by the Abbé Pierre Foundation, this programme **promotes access to decent accommodation or shelter**, and improves the living conditions of Emmaus group members and of the people being cared for.



Countries involved in this programme: Sweden, Burundi, South Africa, Togo.

GROUP ECONOMIC STRENGTHENING PROGRAMME

Countries involved in this programme: Sweden, Burundi, South Africa, Togo. The goal of this programme is **to support economic experiments**, cases of up-or down-scaling, and external support for groups that are struggling.



34 containers shipped, 10 containers funded by the International Container Fund.

CONTAINER PROGRAMME

This programme allows for **material donations to be pooled** within the Movement by sending solidarity containers from European Emmaus groups to groups in Africa and the Americas.
