

Emmaus groups carry out campaigning work at the local level and also put together a joint political statement. **Emmaus International also offers** support to other organisations and social movements that share in our struggle.



PROGRAMMES

Emmaus International is developing mutual health programmes for group members in Africa and Asia. Relying on our member organisations' action on the ground, we are also calling for water infrastructures to be managed by the community, which is a fundamental right.
