ACCESS TO RIGHTS PROGRAMMES

DEVELOP mutual health programmes for people without health access in Africa and Asia.

per group. 22 projects in Africa,

ANNUAL SOLIDARITY PROGRAMME

SUPPORT the most fragile groups with projects which tend to be centred around investments: building, renovations, purchasing materials, etc.

EMERGENCY FUND

RESPOND quickly to emergencies experienced by groups and surrounding populations (natural disasters, armed conflicts, strong sociopolitical tensions, etc.)

HOUSING PROGRAMME

PROMOTE access to decent accommodation or shelter and improve the living conditions of group members and of the people being cared for. (Financed by the Foundation for Housing)

SUPPORT economic experiments, cases of up – or down – scaling, and external support for groups that are struggling.

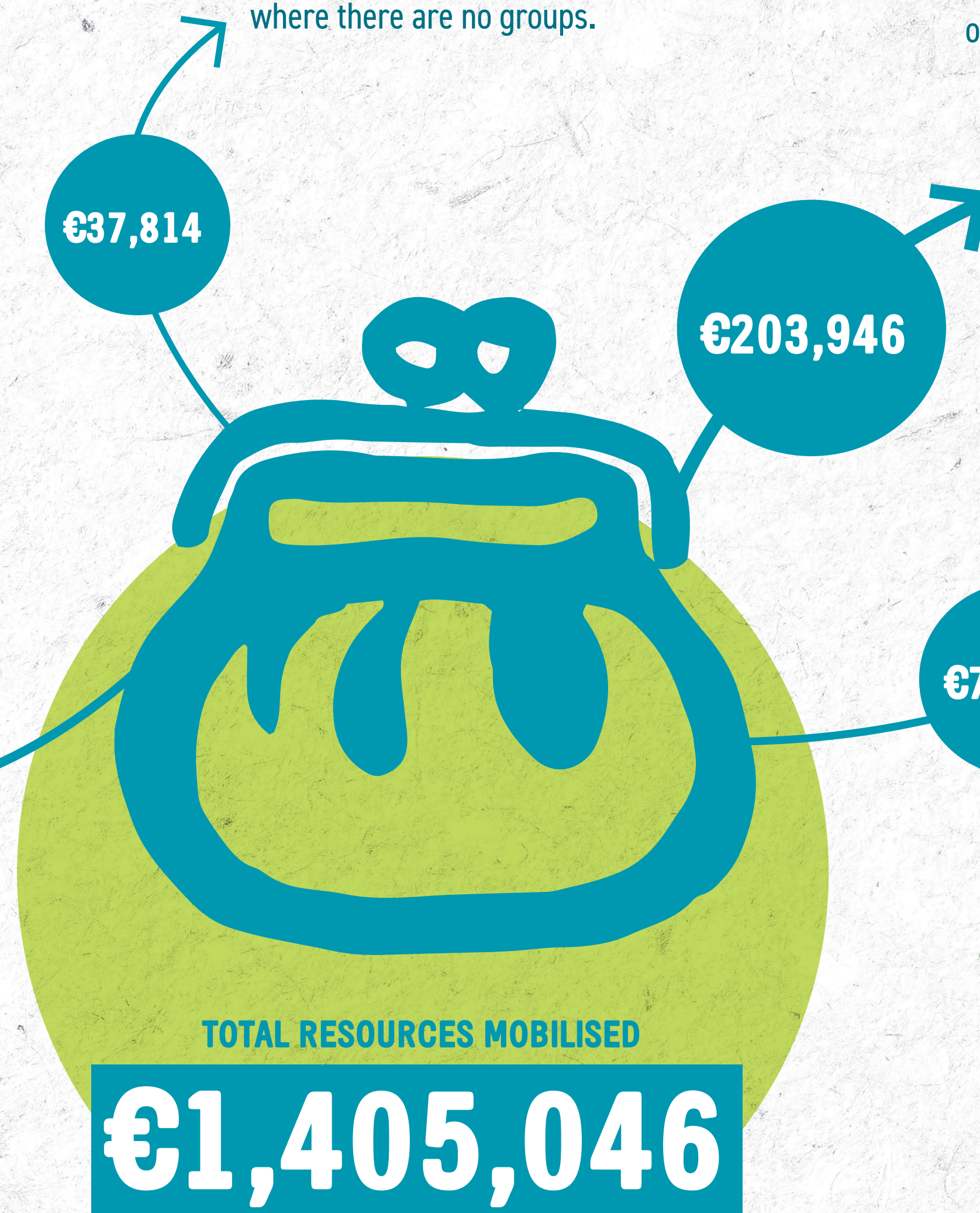
